



THE EMBASSY OF THE UNITED KINGDOM REFUSES TO GUARANTEE THE SAFETY OF BRENDA NAMIGADDE & JAMAL ALI SAÏD

In an email to Total Respect, the Embassy throws doubt on their homosexuality.

Following a month of continuous pressure on the Embassy of the United Kingdom (letters, multiple phone calls, demonstration outside the Embassy) in response to the murder of the Ugandan homosexual activist, David Kato, and the threats of expulsion of two homosexuals from the United Kingdom to Uganda, TOTAL RESPECT - TJENBÉ RÈD FÉDÉRATION (Federation rooted in the Afro-Caribbean communities fighting against all forms of racism, homophobia and AIDS) received an email from the Embassy, indicating, in particular: «*When someone is found not to have a genuine claim we expect them to leave voluntarily*».

In substance, the United Kingdom thus wants to suggest that Brenda Namigadde and Jamal Ali Saïd, who is also HIV positive, have lied about their homosexuality, which, nonetheless, has been confirmed by British LGBT (lesbian, gay, bi- and trans-sexual) groups.

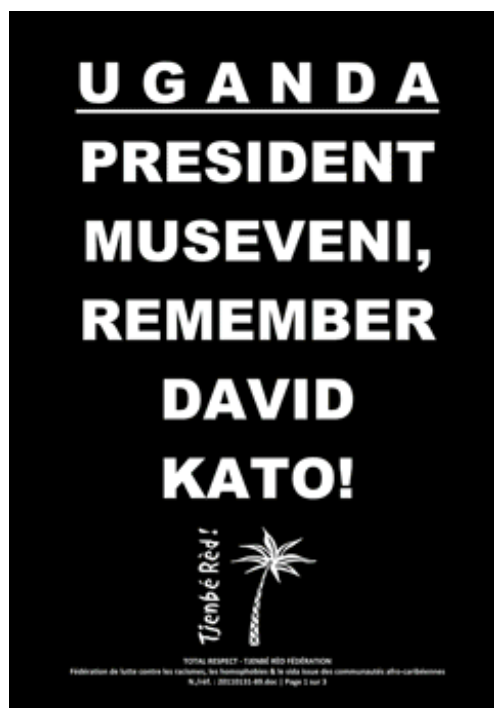
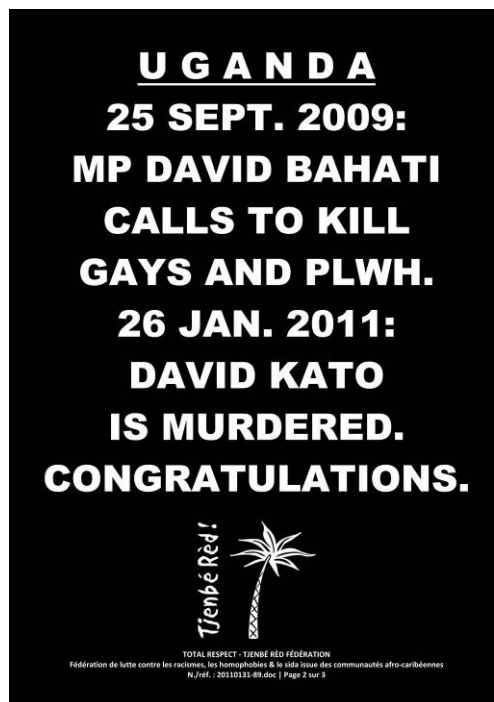
TOTAL RESPECT demands that the United Kingdom guarantees their safety!
